INTERNATIONAL COASTAL CLEANUP AT CANAVERAL NATIONAL SEASHORE

Canaveral National Seashore, Apollo district will join the International Coastal Cleanup on **Saturday, September 19, 2020, 8:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m.** The park invites the public to join the rangers using the new Ocean Conservancy's Clean Swell app. It can be downloaded at the iPhone App Store and Android Play Store. Volunteers participating in the cleanup are encouraged to use the app to record the trash collected. Your trash collection data will be automatically uploaded to the Ocean Conservancy's ocean trash database. The park entrance fee will be waived during the program for all participants. Sign in the day of the event at the Visitor Center in the North District, 7611 South Atlantic Avenue, New Smyrna Beach, FL 32169.

There will not be an official event in the Playalinda District but fees will be waived for visitors cleaning up and a trash bag can be obtained at the entrance station.

Make sure to bring your own gloves and sunscreen. Collection bags and water will be provided. T-shirts will be given to the first 100 people to sign in.
