Friday, December 4th - 10:00 AM “BEACH WALK” - Walk the beach with a ranger and help keep our beaches clean. Discover treasures and help the ranger pick up debris. Walk approximately 1 mile. Gloves and trash bags provided. Meet at parking lot # 1. (1 hour)

Friday, December 11th -10:00 AM “CAST NETTING AT SEMINOLE REST” – Join a ranger at the edge of the lagoon. Learn the art of cast netting and see what may be caught in this area of Mosquito Lagoon. Meet at the Seminole Rest dock. (1 hour)

Saturday, December 12th - 12:00-4:00 PM “SEMINOLE REST OPEN HOUSE” – Join us for a holiday celebration on the cusp of our centennial anniversary. There will be pontoon boat tours, refreshments, crafts, music and more. All are welcome to attend. (4 hours)

Tuesday, December 15th - 10:00 AM “SEMINOLE REST WALK” - Explore with a ranger the grounds once inhabited by the Timucua as well as the post reconstruction era inhabitants of the Seminole Rest home. Meet in the parking lot. (1 hour)

Saturday, December 19th -10:00 AM “CAST NETTING AT PLAYALINDA” – Join a ranger and learn the art of cast netting. See how to catch bait and see what may be caught in this area of Mosquito Lagoon OR on the beach depending on beach conditions. Meet at Eddy Creek parking lot. (1 hour)
