

The majority of the meeting was planning for the spring show at the **American Police Hall of Fame & Museum**. A "pot luck" dinner was absolutely delicious!!!!

TAL Showing at the Wildlife Refuge

Works by **TAL** members will be on display at the **Merritt Island National Wildlife Refuge** for June and July. Take in will be Monday, June 2, between 10-12 and then hang in the afternoon. Also, artists can bring up to four prints, all the same size, which will be marked at \$22 with 20% going to the refuge. The prints will be in the Bookstore which is a **Merritt Island Wildlife Association (MIWA)** gift shop. Two different things here..refuge and friends group (**MIWA**). Each artist must have his or her prints all the same size, but they can be different sizes per artist. They should be matted and ready to frame and not too big since they will be in a display bin in the bookstore. Payment can be in cash, check, or credit card. If credit card, tax will be charged since all payments go through the bookstore cash register. They won't collect tax for cash or check. That'll be up to the artist to take care of that. The \$22 price was established when the Brevard WS had their first show out there. How they arrived at that price is unknown to us, but it has continued through the years. Thank you, Betty Camp, for this information!

Central Brevard Art Association (CBAA), Rockledge


First meeting, Saturday, May 24, 9 am-12


