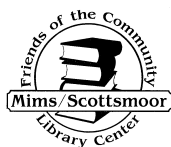



## **BUS STOP**

There is now a Space Coast Area Transit (SCAT) bus stop at the library. Route #5 is the Mims-Titusville route with stops at the Library, Mims Post Office, SR46/US1, Winn Dixie on Dairy Road, BCC at Titusville, Parrish Medical Center, and the County Government Center in Titusville. The bus leaves the library at 8:28am, 9:28am, 10:28am, 11:28am, 2:28pm, 3:28pm, and 4:28pm. At the Government Center you can transfer to buses on Route #1 or Route #2. Full fare = \$1.25 (exact change required) - half fare for Seniors (60+), Disabled, Veterans, and Students. Medicare cards are accepted as proof for half fare. No charge for children under five or transfers.
