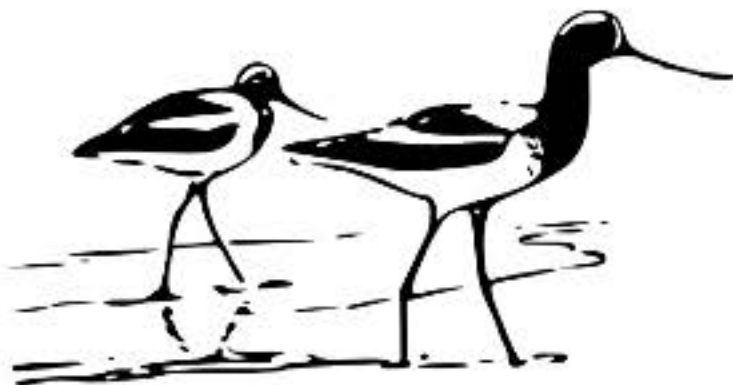

Please note:

*MIWA tours must be scheduled 3 weeks in advance through the MIWA office at (321) 861-2377. Dates and times are subject to shuttle bus and guide availability. Tour group size is limited to 12 total.

*Vouchers for MINWR Refuge Annual Pass will be mailed to the address listed on the application. Vouchers can then be presented at the MINWR front desk in the Visitor Center for an annual pass. Passes may be used by the member or gifted to non-members. Please contact us if you would prefer your pass directly mailed to you.

*KSC Visitor Complex Annual Passes and KSC Visitor Complex Special Interest VIP tours passes will be available after directly calling MIWA at (321) 861-2377. MIWA must be contacted 3 weeks in advance for tickets. KSC will not have any information regarding tickets or tours until after MIWA has been contacted.
