- Your family's most recent tax return (Form 1040) *OR*
- Your Wage and Earning Statement (W-2 Form) *OR*
- Current Pay Stubs (covering the past 4 weeks)

☐ **If your employer offers health insurance, the amount it would cost each month to cover your child or children**

☐ **Your child's proof of citizenship or residency**

- Your child's Social Security number or
- If your child has not yet received a Social Security card, the date you applied for it, *OR*
- Your child's USCIS (immigrant visa) number

Is Your Child Covered?

Affordable health insurance for newborns through age 18.

The Florida KidCare program is what every parent wants. It's quality, affordable insurance to help keep your children healthy. Good health insurance protects them when they're sick—and even when they're not, with regular check-ups.

Who is eligible?

Children who are:

- Under 19 years old
- Uninsured
- U.S. citizens or qualified non-citizens
- Not the dependent of a state employee eligible for health insurance

How much does it cost?

Monthly premiums vary. Most families pay \$15 or \$20 per month.

What services are covered?

Some services are:

- Doctor visits
- Check ups
- Prescriptions
- Hearing and vision tests
- Hospitalization
- Eyeglasses
- Emergency care
- Hearing aids

Where will my children get health care?

They will receive care through licensed doctors, health care professionals and health plans.

How and when do I apply?

What do I need to send?

The type of documents you will need depends on the sources of your family income. For example, you may need to send some of the following:

- Your most recent tax return (Form 1040)
- Your wage and earning statement (W-2 Form)
- Current pay stubs (covering one entire month)
- The cost to add your child or children to health insurance coverage if your employer offers it.
