Following is an update of our fundraisers to date:

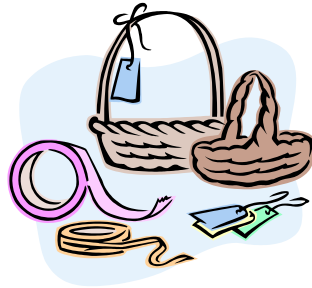
Thanksgiving Hams	-	\$992.66 Profit
