Submission of the application does not guarantee approval of the request. All applications, **which must meet the deadline**, are subject to review and approval by the Grant Review Committee.

Applications must be postmarked by **April 6, 2015**. Please follow the instructions. You may attach additional explanation sheets to the application form. Notification of award or denial will be sent via email. **PLEASE NOTE:** Mini-Grants will not be awarded to previous recipients that did not submit their Final Reports as to the completion of their project.
