What we are: As a part of the Florida Federation of Garden Clubs, (FFGC) we are a partner of the Titusville Garden Club.

We participate in Titusville's "Tree City" initiative to plant 2,000 trees. We partner with Titusville Environmental Commission, Native Plant Society, and local school children. Where we meet: Our business meeting is on the 2nd Tuesday of each month at 10:00 a.m. at the Tree Farm, 1230 Thoreau St. The Tree Farm is open in the morning on Tuesdays and Thursdays.

How we operate: We presently sponsor a March and October Tree and Plant Sale. The sales receipts are used to support the Club, purchase materials and donate plants to the City and other worthy non-profit causes. Some members grow plants to landscape their own homes. Members adopt trees and plants to grow and care for at the Tree Farm.

Is it doing something creative with our hands?

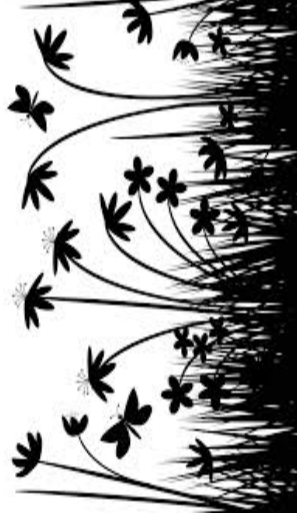
Is it seeing something grow from our care and encouragement?
