- Hand art must be strung together and secured prior to mailing.
- Please include your county on the box used for mailing. We encourage you to decorate the hands with colorful artwork, stories and attach small pictures and/or small posters (no larger than 11x14). Paper plates work well.

### Please note:

- Do not send individuals hands
- Do not send large signs (larger than 11x14)
- Please ensure hands are secured firmly to string/ribbon
