2015 REGISTRATION INFORMATION

Open to Brevard residents with children age 15 and younger. Children must be registered by their parent or guardian.

You will need to bring documents to show proof of:

- Child's name and date of birth (Ex: Birth Certificate, Shot Record)
- Parent or guardian's Brevard residency (Ex: Drivers License, current utility bill)
- If not parent, but legal guardian, proof of guardianship
