



OLDER AMERICANS ACT — Enacted in 1965, along with its more famous siblings, Medicare & Medicaid, the OAA is critical to taking care of those over age 65. It's a safety net to fill the gaps of Social Security in helping seniors live independent lives. Given that more than 10,000 Americans turn 65 every single day in this country, this Act is vital!

Its seven primary sections provide for services such as home-delivered meals, support for family caregivers, transportation to medical appointments, protection from elder abuse and jobs training. Specifically:

- About 11 million Americans are helped directly by programs such as Meals on Wheels and rides to doctors' offices.
- The Act provides guidance and funding to protect seniors from abuse in nursing facilities and elsewhere.
- It funds programs to support independent living as about 90% of older citizens do not want institutional care because of its cost and loss of independence.
- In support of caregivers, the Act provides grants to states to fund counseling and training.
- It promotes part-time work opportunities for low-income senior adults in hospitals, schools and senior centers.
- It focuses on an increasingly larger older population, setting goals for their care.
- The Act establishes federal and local agencies to advocate for the interests and needs of older Americans.

WHAT'S NEXT? The US Senate Committee on Aging is working on:

- Funding more effort to tackle malnourishment and isolation via an expanded Seniors at Lunch program.
- Looking at ways to help the 40 million-plus American caregivers get respite care.
- Attain resources and funding for Americans with Alzheimer's. (The number of citizens with this disease is expected to triple to 14 million by 2050.)
- More assistance with mobility to improve transportation for older Americans.
