



COOKING WITH DOTTI

In remembrance of our beloved Kitchen Manager, Dotti Kunde, we offer one final "Cooking With Dotti" entry:

AMARETTO BREAD PUDDING

8 cups stale Italian stale bread, cubed

5 eggs

2 cups sugar

2 cups milk

2 teaspoons vanilla

1/2 cup brown sugar

1/2 stick butter, melted

1 cup chopped pecans

Mix together eggs & sugar. Pour in milk and add vanilla. Add bread cubes and toss to mix. Pour into a greased 9 x 13 baking pan.

Mix together brown sugar & butter. Add pecans and stir. Sprinkle over bread pudding.

Bake 35 minutes at 350 degrees.

Sauce:

1 cup sugar

1/2 cup melted butter

1 egg, beaten

1/4 cup Amaretto

1 teaspoon vanilla

Stir together sugar, butter & egg over medium heat. Remove from heat and add liquor & vanilla.

Pour over bread pudding when it comes out of the oven. (Heat of pudding will "cook" egg.)

Serve hot or cold, preferably with real whipped cream.

Yield: 20 pieces
